Mackle Park Community Center

- Summer Camp has begun! We have an average of 70-85 kids daily.
- Our fields are being used for both adult & youth sports; Monday – Thursday.
- We are accepting registrations for our new Art Enrichment Camp happening this summer.
- The Spray Park is now open! Additional repairs will be necessary; however it is operational in the meantime.

Racquet Center

- Resurfacing project for Pickleball courts 1-8 is currently in process. Estimated completion day is by 6/20, weather permitting.
- The Fencing project for Pickleball courts 5-8 has been completed.
- A Community Meeting regarding the Racquet Center assessment took place on Thursday, June 9th. The consultant plans on submitting the assessment to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee at its August meeting for recommendation to the City Council.

- A 5-week Baseball Camp is occurring throughout the summer months.

- The Calusa Garden Club is currently working on their new garden display.

We currently have a private contractor helping with Growth Management reviews on an interim basis until we fill our vacant positions.
