The application type “Building” will be discontinued.

New Self-Issuing Permits

A Self-Issuing Permit process for select application types has been implemented.

Qualifying building permits include: A/C replacements; Water Heater replacements; Irrigation; and Low Voltage Alarm Label that do not require plan review but do require inspection or other activities after issuance. Users will apply through the Public Portal as they do now, and if all the qualifying information for a “no review needed” permit is supplied, the Public Portal will issue a payment slip. A “Pay Fees button” will show on the Public Portal screen allowing them to access the payment portal. Once the fees are paid, permit documents will load to the Public Portal where the customer can download them as usual. The Public Portal will check the contractor’s license and address for validity and will notify the contractor that an application has been received. Permits for Garage Sales and Recreational Vehicle Parking are also available as self-issuing permits through the Public Portal. This new capability replaces the paper process previously managed through the Code Enforcement Division team.
