PARKS MASTER PLANNING

Village of Estero, FL

Sabrina served as project manager in 2019 on this master planning assignment for Estero Community Park, working directly with David Willems, the Village's director of Parks & Recreation and Public Works. RVI (formerly Waldrop) produced multiple iterations of a master planning study to visualize how to incorporate new expansion to the park, elementary and high school properties, which included multiple sports fields, pickleball for the park, a trail system, maintenance facility, and adequate parking and circulation to remedy traffic congestion concerns in the area.



EVERGLADES WONDER GARDENS

City of Bonita Springs, FL

Sabrina worked with the City and the Bonita Wonder Gardens Organization on site plan approvals for the addition of garden pavilions to enhance the Wonder Gardens visitor experience. This historic property contains tropical Florida plants and an array of regional birds, reptiles and wildlife. Master planning and design for the Gardens has been approached with care to minimize impact to the natural elements on property. Four garden pavilions were designed to host small gatherings, and contain tropical habitat plantings for pollinators.



UNIVERSITY PARKWAY ENHANCEMENTS

Manatee County, FL

Sabrina served as project manager for the landscape renovation and enhancement along 2.6 miles of University Parkway, located in the County's Lakewood Ranch District. This project was a cost-share agreement between two private developers and the Lakewood Ranch District. Concept plans and perspectives were developed to provide a unified streetscape vision and consistent streetscape character for the length of the parkway, highlighting developer main entries. Enhancements to the existing roadway plantings consisted of introducing varied textures and heights, sustainable and maintainable species, year-round color, and the use of large Oak trees and Date palms to provide mature canopy coverage. Landscape was required to meet the latest FDOT requirements and budget approved in the cost-share agreement. Sabrina's team provided concept plans and preliminary estimate, landscape and irrigation permit plans for the County, project budget and coordination meetings through completion of the project.

ON A PERSONAL NOTE

Sabrina enjoys volunteering to coach girls U-12 soccer teams in Collier County, and has been actively involved through the years in coaching youth sports or volunteering in local parks programs.
