Your Vote is Your Voice

Any registered Voter in Florida may vote by mail. Request your Vote-by-Mail (VBM) ballot online or by contacting the Supervisor of Elections office by 5 pm Aug 8.

Closed Primary - what you need to know:

In Florida, you can only vote for candidates from your registered party in the primary election. Non-partisan races are open to all registered voters. If a partisan race only has candidates from one party, the winning candidate will be chosen from the primary candidates of that party. Voters from other parties can temporarily change their party affiliation to participate in the primary and then change back.
