Competitions: Ann Dougherty

- Springtime Competition was successful.
- 602 skaters registered and 578 skated after withdrawals. There were 250 new skaters
- There were few issues reported
 - 3 injuries
 - Too much hair/makeup in food area
 - Safe sport issues with 16 year old coach

Office Report: Craig Forsyth

• Report was presented.

- 1) Monday May 22nd we have 67 skaters registered for Summer 2023.
- 2) **LTS MEMBERSHIP**: As of Monday May 22nd we have 722 LTS members. An increase of 7 since last month. Last year AAFSC had 711 LTS members.
- 3) **MEMBERSHIP**: AAFSC membership with USFS as of Sunday May 22nd reached 590 members (*a decrease of* "9" since last month). Total USFS membership for 2021/22 (end of May 2022) was 511.
- 4) **OFFICE STAFF:** Kyra Christensen has joined the AAFSC Office team for Summer 2023.
- 5) **SUMMER ICE:** June ice is now open for purchase. July/August ice will open on/about June 1st
- 6) **AA SKILLS & SHOWCASE ANNOUNCEMENT:** As of noon on Monday May 22nd we have received registrations from 88 skaters representing 139 starts. Registration continues thru Wednesday May 24th. We expect to have competition from 8am to 5:30pm,
- 7) **COLLEGE MEMBERSHIP:** Email letters have gone out offering a gift of 4-year Collegiate membership in USFS for all club members who are graduating seniors this year.
- 8) **EBLASTS:** Our goal is to provide as much information as possible. In the last month we have sent 26 eblasts. Topics included, Competition Results, Skate Sharpening, Springtime Volunteers, Sue Adamson, Summer Ice and more. The average opening is 70.0.
