Chapter 1 Overview of Alzheimer's Disease & Dementia: Introduction, Diagnosis, Treatment •

This chapter is designed to introduce the caregiver to the definition of dementia and an overview of some of the prevalent diseases that cause dementia. • There is a discussion of diagnosis, treatment, and prognosis. •

Discuss also includes risk factors, genetic probability, and the need for more research and public awareness.

## Chapter 2 Communications & Feelings •

Focus the importance of effective communication when interacting with a client that suffers from the symptoms of dementia. • Explores the importance of both verbal and nonverbal communications • Discuss importance of empathy, sensitivity, and awareness of the client especially during the stages where they have lost their verbal communication skills.

## Chapter 3 Depression and Repetitive Expressions •

This chapter explores the prevalence of depression in the dementia population. • Discussion also includes treatment approaches/intervention in lieu of medications. • This presentation explains the importance of detailed assessment to rule out other contributions to one's cognition such as substance abuse/misuse and reversible cognitive conditions. • Discuss repetitive behaviors

Chapter 4 Delusions, Hallucinations, Hoarding & Wandering •

This chapter discusses aggressive behaviors and catastrophic reactions, possible causes for them and appropriate interventions

• This chapter encourages facilities to provide non-violent self-protection training for staff to ensure safety and to reduce the risk

of injuries to all involved. •

Chapter 5 This chapter focuses on intimacy and sexuality in the elder population, offering insights to encourage sensitivity, respect, and appropriate interventions when faced with caregiving scenarios of intimate nature.

Chapter 6 -Personal Care: Pain, Nutrition, Bathing, Dressing, Toileting, Falls, & Sleep Disturbances •

This chapter discusses the role of one's involvement in assessing pain of the cognitively impaired client. • Interventions and considerations for enhancing nutrition and the overall dining experience are addressed. • Effective care techniques are covered regarding bathing, dressing, toileting, and fall prevention.

Chapter 7 Activities • This chapter considers parallel programming to ensure that varied activities are facilitated to meet all levels of cognition in the facility. •

Explains the importance of offering activities that reflect one's personal interests, hobbies, and work history. • This chapter reinforces that programs should be stress oriented, failure free, purposeful and meaningful.

Chapter 8 Environment • This chapter explains the importance of environmental modification to promote the optimal therapeutic environment for those who suffer with dementia and related disorders.

In addition, environmental modifications as well as outdoor strategies, interventions while considering fire and safety regulations.

Chapter 9 Staff and Family Support & Abuse and Neglect Prevention •

This chapter examines the needs of the family and our professional role as a support resource with sensitivity to the needs of the resident and concerns of the family.
