Invitation for Bids

The City of Glen Rose will receive bids for TxCDBG 2020 Street and Drainage Improvements project until 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 2, 2020 at Glen Rose City Hall, located at 201 N E Vernon, Glen Rose, Texas 76043, at which time the Bids received will be publically opened and read aloud.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

1. The Base Bid includes street and drainage improvements along approximately 780 linear feet of 4th Street, including removal of existing pavement, installation of new asphalt pavement with curb and gutter, installation of approximately 540 linear feet of storm drain ranging from 2'x4' concrete box culvert to 18" RCP, storm drain inlets, headwalls, and construction of a detention pond. Additive Alternate 1 includes street improvements along approximately 260 linear feet of Clay Street, including removal of existing pavement, installation of new asphalt pavement with curb and gutter, and misc. roadway construction items. Additive Alternate 2 includes street improvements along approximately 260 linear feet of Webster Street, including removal of existing pavement, installation of new asphalt pavement with curb and gutter, and misc. roadway construction items.

The Bidding Documents, including Drawings and Technical Specifications may be obtained from Civcast at www.civcastusa.com. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents, Drawings and Technical Specifications at the Engineer's Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., and the City of Glen Rose's office, on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Glen Rose or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.

The City of Glen Rose reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the City of Glen Rose for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
