Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

The City of Stockdale will receive bids for CDBG Project No. 7219430, City of Stockdale Waterline Improvements for 12” Waterline until 2pm on May 4th, 2020 at 700 W. Main St., Stockdale, Tx 78160. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2pm on May 4th, 2020 at 700 W. Main St., Stockdale, Tx 78160.

Bids are invited for several items and quantities of work as follows:

The project consists of the installation of approximately 2,425 LF of 12” waterline, gate valves, fire hydrants, street repairs, curb repair, driveway repair and water service connections.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Stockdale or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than, the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.
