


Message From Pastor Ron

I was appointed on July 1 to my new church appointment, Broadway United Methodist Church. We have been unable to worship together due to COVID. I have met a few people who dropped by the church and also met some church members at a Sunday School picnic (we wore masks and practiced social distancing.) Also, I have met people at zoom meetings. Churches in Holston are still unable to have in-person worship services in the church building. Currently, Holston Conference is only allowing outdoor worship (which may change by the time you read this.) District Superintendent Jason Gattis approved our plans for outdoor worship which requires certain guidelines to be met such as wearing masks, & social distancing to be practiced. Our in-person worship guidelines had already been approved.

Our first outdoor worship service was held in the church parking lot on August 16. It was a glorious Sunday morning with the sun shining and worshipers praising God. Church members and visitors were present. We will continue to have outdoor worship (unless weather prevents it) until we can resume in-person worship. Please make a reservation on the church's website or call Tami if you are planning to attend. We are required to keep a record of attendance in case there is an outbreak of COVID. In case of rain the outdoor worship service will be cancelled and live streamed.
