

# SMART manufacturing

## Criteria for consideration:

- **Researchers:** Significant contributions to the advancement of smart manufacturing knowledge, which includes: research contributions to manufacturing models, processes and/or systems; conduct of seminars and/or workshops that are focused on advanced manufacturing (digital-enabled technologies); publication of papers and/or books.

## Eligibility:

Participants must hold a faculty position within an accredited university. Twenty candidates will be selected for inclusion in the June Issue of SME's Smart Manufacturing Magazine
