

Pequot Lakes businesses invited to decorate for Dec. 10 contest

PEQUOT LAKES — While Community Action of Pequot Lakes continues to organize the annual Santa's Bobbin' into Town event, the organization is also working with the city and its "Griswold Committee" to get Pequot Lakes "crazy with lights." The goal is to have every business in the downtown area and on Patriot Avenue

and Rasmussen Road decorate the outside of their business with holiday lights. Businesses should be decorated before Saturday, Nov. 26. The decorating contest will be "judged" by the community's response to Facebook posts. Votes may be cast on the Community Action of Pequot Lakes Facebook page.

Cash prizes are \$300 for first place, \$150 for second place and \$50 for third place. Winners will be notified by phone Thursday, Dec. 1. The Griswold Committee (named from the movie "Christmas Vacation") plans new lighting features in North Trailside Park, including a "Mayor's Tree" that

will be lit at a ceremony just before the Santa's Bobbin' Light Up the Night Parade at 6 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 10. Community Action's traditional bonfire, hot chocolate and cookies, Bobber Hunt and horse and wagon rides will continue to be in South Trailside Park that day. Businesses may participate
