

INTERRUPTING PRIVILEGE

Join us for a parent workshop, Interrupting Privilege:



This workshop asks participants to reflect deeply on their own positions of privilege - and lack thereof - as well as how one group's privilege shores up another group's inequality. We connect data about structural inequities to the everyday realities of our own lives. The workshop begins with some grounding information about racism and systems of privilege, including important terminology.

Throughout this session participants engage in activities that allow them to consider their own positions in systems of inequality and privilege, and begin imagining what interrupting these systems might entail.
