Enrollment is now open for the first session of the “JazzCats” Jazz Band, led by instrumental music teacher Mark Oesterle. This session will run from early March through June. **What a great opportunity for a young musician to get more time on their instrument playing in an ensemble setting, and to learn the art of improvisation and America’s great art form: Jazz!**

WHAT: “The JazzCats” Jazz Band. Students learn jazz scales, rhythm, and harmony, with an emphasis on improvisation. All in a fun, relaxed environment.

WHO: Open to 4th and 5th Grade Elementary Instrumental Musicians. Jazz instruments include trumpets, saxophones, flutes, clarinets, and trombones. Rhythm section includes piano, drums, bass and guitar.

WHEN: Thursday afternoons from 3:30 to 4:30 pm. There will be 13 classes during this session, which runs every Thursday from November 8th until March 7th.

NOTE: **NO JAZZ on December 20th** before Winter Break. Performance date of March 7th at Nathan Hale HS.
