MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Working towards a Bachelor's degree in Sport Management or a related field. Strong writing skills and strong attention to detail required. Prior experience in athletics operations and facility management is preferred. This internship begins no later than the first day of classes and ends no earlier than the last reading day. All applicants must be seniors in their final semester and receive credit for all internship hours (40 hours/week)

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

There are two positions available for each semester (Fall--August through December, Spring--January through April and Summer--April through August). Interns will assist with game management and operation of all assigned athletic events (Football, Volleyball, Soccer, Men's Basketball and Women's Basketball, Baseball, Gymnastics, Softball) and daily office activities. Willingness to work evenings and weekends is required.
