Position Description - Press Break Operator

<u>Summary of Position</u> - The press break operator is responsible for producing quality parts with cost effective procedures. He / She is responsible to ensure the press Break and all associated tooling is in good working order. The operator is required to work safe, report all deficiencies of production parts, equipment and tooling to his/her immediate supervisor.

<u>Core Competencies</u> - the successful Candidate must display the following attributes as a core part of their interaction while working for the company.

A high degree of accuracy and quality is required on all bending tasks. The current press Brake at Michaud has a capacity of 250 tons.
