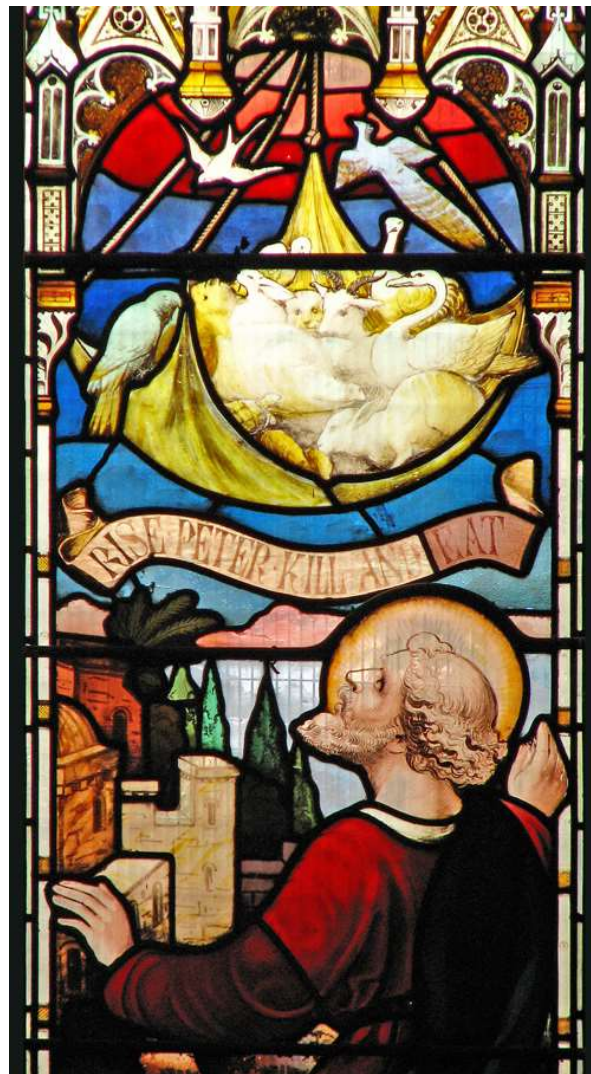

opens to new stories of harm and new visions of flourishing

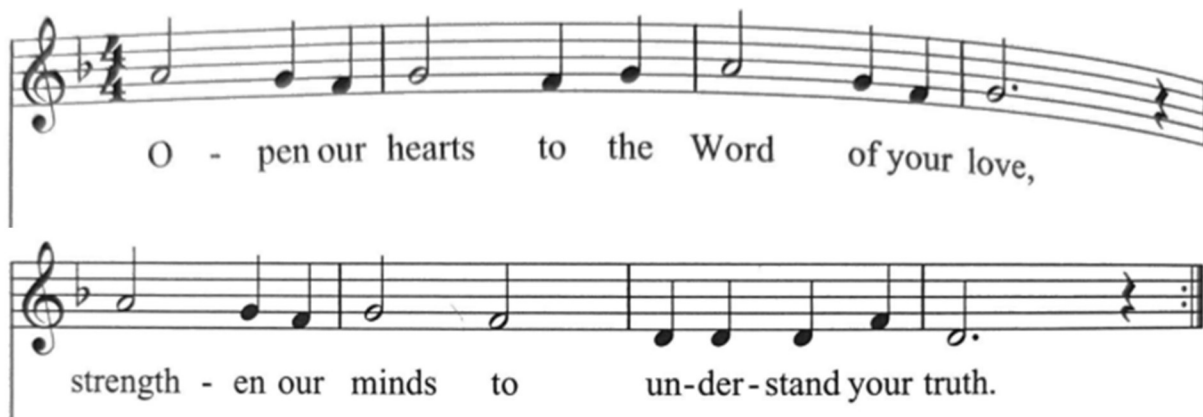
**All: we join together to embody Love's accountability

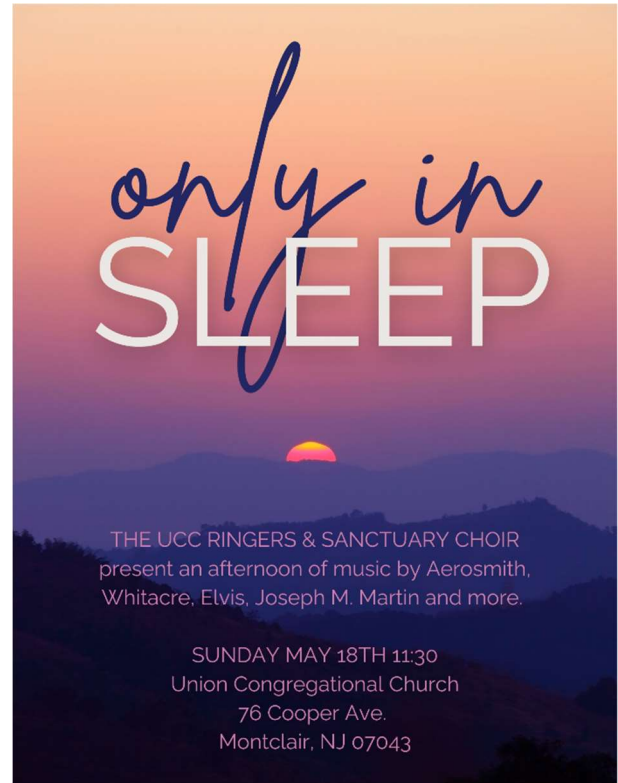
