Reigniting Your Passion for God — Nested Outline (with Scripture)

I. Big Idea: Love God Passionately

- A. The Great Commandment—whole-life love
- 1. Mark 12:30 "Love the Lord your God with all your heart... soul... mind... strength."
- 2. Colossians 3:23 "Whatever you do, do it heartily, as for the Lord..."
- 3. Romans 12:11 "Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor..."

II. Why Passion Matters

- A. Passion fuels purpose and endurance
- 1. Ecclesiastes 9:10 "Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might."
- 2. *Philippians 3:12–14* Press on toward the goal.
- 3. 2 Timothy 1:6 "Fan into flame the gift of God..."

III. Seven Passion Killers (and Biblical Antidotes)

A. Unbalanced Schedule

- 1. Problem: Too much output or too much input
- Ecclesiastes 3:1 "To everything there is a season."
- Psalm 127:2 God gives His beloved sleep.
- Mark 6:31 "Come away... and rest a while."
- 2. Antidote: Train for godliness and build rhythm
- 1 Timothy 4:7–8 "Train yourself for godliness."

B. Unused Talent

- 1. Problem: Gifts shelved → boredom/burnout
- 1 Peter 4:10 Use your gift to serve others.
- 1 Corinthians 12:4–7 Gifts given "for the common good."
- 2. Antidote: Serve where you're shaped
- Romans 12:6–8 Use the grace-gifts.

C. Unconfessed Sin

- 1. Problem: Guilt suffocates joy and zeal
- Psalm 32:3-5 Silence drained strength; confession brought relief.
- Psalm 38:4, 6 Guilt as a heavy burden.
- 2. Antidote: Confess and receive cleansing
- 1 John 1:9 He is faithful and just to forgive.

D. Unresolved Conflict

- 1. Problem: Resentment, jealousy, prolonged anger drain passion
- Job 5:2 Resentment destroys; jealousy kills.
- Job 18:4 "You are only hurting yourself with your anger."
- Ephesians 4:26-27, 31-32 Don't let anger linger; forgive.
- 2. Antidote: Reconcile and release

- Matthew 5:23–24 Go and be reconciled.
- Romans 12:18 "As far as it depends on you..."

E. Unsupported Lifestyle

- 1. Problem: Isolation cools the heart
- Ecclesiastes 4:9–10 Two are better than one.
- Hebrews 10:24–25 Don't neglect meeting; spur one another on.
- 2. Antidote: Commit to community
- Acts 2:42 Teaching, fellowship, breaking bread, prayers.

F. Unclear Purpose

- 1. Problem: Motion without meaning breeds apathy
- Isaiah 49:4 "I have labored in vain..."
- Proverbs 19:21 The Lord's purpose prevails.
- 2. Antidote: Re-center on God's calling
- Ephesians 2:10 Created for good works.
- Philippians 1:21 "To live is Christ."

G. Undernourished Spirit

- 1. Problem: Pressures shrink the soul when unfed
- Deuteronomy 8:3 / Matthew 4:4 Man lives by every word of God.
- John 15:5 Abide to bear fruit.
- 2. Antidote: Daily nourishment
- Joshua 1:8 Meditate day and night.
- Psalm 63:1 "My soul thirsts for You."

IV. Reignite the Fire: Practice the Five Purposes in Balance

- A. Worship Personal & corporate
- John 4:23–24; Psalm 29:2
- B. **Fellowship** Life-giving relationships
- Acts 2:42; Hebrews 10:24-25
- C. **Discipleship** Word, prayer, obedience
- 2 Timothy 3:16–17; Colossians 3:16
- D. Ministry Serve with your gifts
- Ephesians 4:11–12; 1 Peter 4:10
- E. **Mission** Share the gospel
- Matthew 28:18-20; 2 Corinthians 5:20

V. Remember God's Passion for You

- A. God's jealous (zealous) love
- Exodus 34:14 "The LORD... is a jealous God."
- B. The cross as the proof
- Romans 5:8; 1 John 4:9–10 Love demonstrated in Christ.
- *Isaiah 53:5* Pierced for our transgressions.
- C. Communion as remembrance
- 1 Corinthians 11:23-26; Luke 22:19

VI. Weekly Rhythm to Sustain Passion

- A. **Daily:** Word & prayer (*Psalm 5:3; Mark 1:35*)
- B. Weekly: Gather & rest (Hebrews 10:25; Exodus 20:8–10)
- C. **Regular Retreats:** Rest and recalibrate (*Mark 6:31*)

VII. Self-Examination & Response

- A. Holy Spirit search
- Psalm 139:23-24 "Search me... lead me."
- B. Consecration
- Romans 12:1–2 Present your bodies; be transformed.
- C. Commitment: Identify your #1 passion-killer and take one obedient step this week (tie to Scriptures above).

VIII. Closing Prayer Points

- A. Confession and cleansing (1 John 1:9)
- B. Fresh filling and fire (Ephesians 5:18; Acts 4:31)
- C. Bold love and zeal (Romans 12:11; Colossians 3:23)
