## WHAT IS AN ADULT EDUCATION BRIDGE PROGRAM?

Bridge is a program of classes that allows students to obtain their high school equivalency (GED®/HiSet®) while learning skills that help them prepare for work. Careers that are highlighted include entry-level positions such as Warehousing, Equipment Operator, Drivers, Shipping & Receiving and Material Handler. Students are exposed to pathways for careers in Logistics, Supply Chain Management, Freight Broker, and other fields in Transportation, Distribution, and Logistics (TDL).

## WHAT SUPPORT DOES TDL BRIDGE PROVIDE?

- Opportunity to earn a basic Forklift Operator certificate
- Personalized tutoring to build reading, writing, and math skills
- Discounts on practice and official HSE (GED®/HiSet®) tests
- Travel assistance with Ventra cards
- Transitional support to college careers after program completion

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

Students attend classes Monday through Thursday and includes test-Taking Strategies and Computers/Digital Literacy. Students prepare for subjects on the HSE (GED®/HiSet®) tests. Students will also take a course in Business and Forklift Operator as part of the program.
