Babysitter's Club Essentials: Babysitter Safety is designed to prepare students in grades 6-8 to be safe when they're home alone, watching younger siblings, or babysitting. The Instructor-led class is filled with fun games and role-playing exercises. Babysitter's will learn all the skills necessary to take care of young children, manage behaviors and prevent unsafe situations. They will also learn basic choking rescue and how to respond to illnesses and injuries while learning to stay in control of themselves and the children in their care. Babysitters will practice skills to screen jobs, greet parents and become young entrepreneurs. The course uses games, skills practices, guided discussions and a digital presentation.

Babysitters will meet at SI after school every Tuesday from 2:30-3:30pm.
