

Indoor Water Safety

There are a number of water safety tips we should be aware of year-round, since water safety and the possibility of drowning exists even within our homes.

Children should NEVER be left unsupervised when bathing--even for a minute. Have everything you need for bath time in place BEFORE the child enters the water.

Infants under the age of 1 are most likely to drown in a bathtub

Toilet locks should be installed and used as toddlers may fall face first into a toilet while playing, and due to their disproportionately large head, be unable to right themselves.

All doors leading to pools or spas should have locks and alarms--even doggy doors.
