1. Safe Kids GF worked with the Grand Forks Park District and the Greenway to create a sledding safety sign to help remind children and parents alike of sledding safety tips when out enjoying the sledding hill. This sign is located at the sledding hill on Belmont Rd and 13th Ave S. We are grateful to the GF Park District and the Greenway for their partnership.
2. South Middle School got some new traffic lights installed! This will help keep the students at South Middle School much safer when they are coming to and from school each day. We are thankful to the City of Grand Forks for helping to get these lights installed.
3. Lewis & Clark faculty came to us with an issue they were seeing and hearing from students. The flashing beacon that helps them cross the street to school is push button activated. The students were unsure when they were pushing the button if the lights above them were coming on to warn the drivers. The City of Grand Forks engineers came up with this solution in the furthest right photo where a light flashes to show the students that the light above them is on to warn drivers that a student is waiting to cross. We are thankful to the City of Grand Forks Engineers for their timely response to help keep the students at Lewis & Clark safe!
