Identify a family with concerns or needs in ECD.



Share the ENRICH-LAC Family Partners role with the family.

Meet Your Family Partners

ENRICH-LAC integrates Family Partners (FPs) into pediatric care teams to improve access to ECD and EI services.

Family Partners are parents or caregivers who have firsthand experience navigating systems to support their children's needs. They bring empathy, community understanding, and practical insights to your care team. Think of them as your bridge to families! FPs can help with:



Resource and systems navigation: Regional center referrals and beyond! FPs connect caregivers to FREE and low-cost community services and supports.



Advocacy: FPs can assist with educational plans and help caregivers confidently communicate with any provider about their child's needs.



Emotional support: Navigating developmental concerns can be overwhelming. FPs provide a safe space for caregivers to share their concerns and needs.
