Through Reach Out and Read, pediatric teams can provide new, age- and language-appropriate books and share literacy advice with children and parents at each well-child visit. Reach Out and Read has become an essential part of pediatric practice across the country—from large, urban practices to small, rural clinics. By introducing a beautiful new book at the beginning of a well-child visit, providers find they can better engage and calm the child, provide meaningful, positive literacy promotion messages to the parent or caregiver, enable additional opportunities for positive caregiver/child interactions, and build stronger connections with the family. Using the book in the exam room creates an opportunity to talk about other relevant topics such as sleep routines, the importance of a child's first 2,000 days, school readiness—and offers providers a new and valuable tool for monitoring the child's development. Furthermore, Reach Out and Read encounters are often some of the most joyful moments of a provider's day.

I urge you to consider making Reach Out and Read part of your clinic's best practices. This is a program that I have been implementing in my own office with great success.
