

## John Stark Academic Support

Edgenuity Credit Recovery for students who need it (because they've failed a class), have moved in from another district and need to fill in credits, and also for students taking a class on Edgenuity as an ELO (extended learning opportunity) (Edgenuity.com)

Students doing VLAC classes independently and need time during the day at Stark can be scheduled in here to work on their classes (VLACs.org)

A place that ALL students at ALL levels can come to for additional support with their academics (general ed, special ed, AP, etc...). All levels of ability are welcomed!

The program will provide academic support for students who have missed, or will miss, a significant amount of school due to a planned or unplanned absence.

Support for academics, study skills, assessment preparation, writing assignments, reading comprehension assistance, clarification of concepts taught in academic classes, time management and organizational skills.

Students can come to study independently, receive assistance from a teacher or aide, and/or work interactively with peer tutors from NHS.

This is a regular ed intervention available to all students, it is not a special ed placement or service.

## There are three ways a student can be in the room to get support:

- Students can be assigned in here by guidance on their schedule.
- Students can be sent down during a class for the opportunity to receive clarification and reinforcement of a concept, take an assessment, or for extra practice. They will come with a written pass and any work needed to be working on.
- Students can self-direct themselves to the program by coming to me during a block before their study hall to obtain a written pass from myself or the aide that they can show their study hall teacher. This is like the library pass system. If the room is too full or if students are not working productively, they will be sent back to their study hall.
