

Established in 2013, as part of an integrated health system, AHN serves western Pennsylvania and parts of New York, Ohio, and West Virginia.



Cancer Institute

Our oncology teams give patients the care and support they need to fight cancer. Doctors offer proven treatments and research new options for care, providing patients with the best possible outcome for all types of cancer.

Most cancer care is provided at community-based locations. We have one of Pennsylvania's largest bone marrow and cell transplant programs. Our affiliation with the Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center at Johns Hopkins promotes clinical collaborations, medical education, and cancer research.

AHN oncologists personalize patient treatment based on the disease site and individual genetics. Together with Johns Hopkins, we have a combined portfolio of phase 1, 2, and 3 clinical trials from federal, industry, and investigator-initiated trials.



Cardiovascular Institute

Our doctors perform more than 2,000 heart surgeries a year, including heart transplants. They work closely with each patient to provide the best treatments and to prevent heart problems when possible, including:

- Atrial fibrillation treatment
- Advanced heart surgery
- Mechanical heart assistance
- Lung and esophageal surgery
- Minimally invasive and robotic-assisted heart, valve, and vascular surgery

Our patients have access to new medicines and innovative tools being researched through clinical trials, such as:

- Advanced hybrid procedures
- Implantable devices to monitor disease progression



Emergency Medicine

Community residents rest easy knowing that full-service emergency departments are close by for urgent health care whenever the need arises. Our emergency departments are designated as:

In addition, AHN's LifeFlight was the first air medical service in the northeastern U.S. and continues to provide emergency care and transportation across the tri-state region.
