Our annual North American and Biennial European Conferences are the major catalysts for scholarly exchange and are the focal points of our in-person educational activities. SMDM publishes two journals: Medical Decision Making focuses on methodological work and systematic approaches to decision making, and MDM Policy & Practice, an open access journal, focuses on applications to problems facing decision-makers, including patients, providers, and payers. The journals have become increasingly influential as a rigorous source of important new knowledge – clinical and methodological – as well as a place to find authoritative review articles and incisive editorials.

Mission Statement: The mission of SMDM is “to improve health outcomes through the advancement of proactive systematic approaches to clinical decision-making and policy formation in health care by providing a scholarly forum that connects and educates researchers, providers, policy makers, and the public”. As such, we promote an analytic, integrated approach to health care decision making in an inspiring, energizing, respectful, collegial, and friendly learning environment.

Vision: Our vision is that systematic proactive approaches should be used for decision making in health care. We are promoting an integrated approach to health care decision making based on multiple perspectives and expertise from multiple disciplines. Optimal communication among those involved in healthcare decisions will facilitate informed and shared decision-making by policymakers, physicians, patients, and the public.



SMDM ANNUAL MEETING

SMDM's Annual Meeting provides a highly interactive forum for discussion of novel research based on psychology, economics, decision theory, and analytical models applied to health-related decisions. Presentations of original research, keynote talks, special symposia and short courses will offer attendees the opportunity to explore diverse topics related to medical decision making.

Meetings typically draw **500 – 600 attendees** from a variety of professional backgrounds and academic disciplines. They work in hospitals, universities, private corporations, foundations, and government agencies across the globe.
