NOTES...

- 4-day gives more time to explore "big" questions and develop an Action Plan, and may feel less rushed. May be better suited to a national group traveling longer distances.
- 4-day time-frame may be more appealing bigger "investment."
- 3-day is less costly (save one night and 3 meals) and may be a good "pilot" to find out what works best.
- 3-day Better to have not enough time than too much time? May feel rushed. May be better suited to a regional group (AZ or Phoenix) traveling shorter distances.
