

Prayer Guide – January through March 2018

We invite you to partner in prayer that the Holy Spirit would use us to go into our communities with hearts of service and voices that share the good news of Jesus Christ, multiplying the harvest in all our churches.

During the week of...

January 7 – As we celebrate Epiphany, we thank our Lord for revealing Himself to us through the life and work of Jesus Christ in our behalf. We ask that this light of Christ would shine in and through us as we work to multiple new starts, and as He grows the Kingdom through multiplying new believers.
