LET'S GET READY TO MARCH ON WASHINGTON, DC ON JUNE 20, 2020

In the words of Reverend Dr. William J. Barber II, "Somebody is hurting our people and it's gone on far too long. We won't . . . We can't. . . We refuse to be silent anymore. We must rise in the public square, in pulpits, in the voting booths, in state capitals, in the Congress AND ON JUNE 20, 2020 in Washington, DC!

Join your brothers and sisters of Binkley as we march with Reverend Barber and others to highlight the injustices of racism, poverty, ecological devastation, militarism and the distorted moral narrative of religious nationalism.

WHEN IS IT?: **Saturday, June 20, 2020 in Washington, DC** at the Northeast corner of the National Mall in Washington, DC on Pennsylvania Ave. NW extending west from 3rd St. NW. Starting time: 10 a.m.

SO, TELL ME MORE . . . A group of Binkley folks are arranging a trip to participate in this march. Some rooms have been booked in Fredericksburg, VA (about an hour south of DC) for the nights of Friday, June 19th and Saturday, June 20th. We'll plan to arrive Friday afternoon in Fredericksburg, VA, get a good night's rest and then take the DC MARCH RALLY BUS that will depart Fredericksburg at 7:26 am and will return to Fredericksburg around 5:30 pm. The Rally point pick up/drop location is approximately 15 minutes from the hotel. We've booked some tickets on that Rally Bus. We'll plan to find a convenient place to have supper and debrief together after our day in Washington.

WHAT IS THE COST?: Approximately \$230 for 2 nights, single occupancy and \$115 for 2 nights, per person/double occupancy at the hotel (including breakfast each morning) and \$25 roundtrip for the bus ticket.

NOTE: The hotel has a generous cancellation policy. The Rally bus tickets (\$25) will be nonrefundable, but can be gifted over to someone else as needed.
