Lead Teacher-The Lead Teacher is responsible for health and safety of up to 12 children in his/her care, supervision of children, lesson planning, conducting the daily program activities, meeting all educational mandates of IFSP/IEP's, building a strong classroom team, and collaboration with Assistant Teachers and other building staff. The Lead Teacher is ultimately responsible for administrative and teaching duties in the assigned classroom. Lead Teachers are responsible for participating in, continuing, and maintaining CEU's and any NC EESLPD or NC DCDEE required professional development towards maintenance of his/her NC teaching license. Early Head Start Teacher- The teacher, in collaboration with the co-teacher, shall be responsible for planning and implementing the daily program activities and meeting all classroom-related mandates of Head Start Performance Standards for a group of 7/8 toddlers. The EHS Toddler Teacher serves as the Primary Caregiver for up to 4 children, and is responsible for ongoing assessment and record-keeping, implementing the Creative Curriculum for Toddlers, establishing regular and open communication with families, and participating as a member of the classroom.
