Greetings from the Hot Lunch Program!

Each year we review our hot lunch program and complete a Paid Lunch Equity tool to help decide on the best costs for our program and our families. After this year's review, we have decided to increase the cost of student and adult lunches beginning September 1, 2019. The cost of student lunch will increase from \$2.75 to 2.85. The cost of adult lunch will increase from \$3.50 to \$3.90. Both costs, the student lunch and adult lunch, include milk. The cost of milk only or additional milk to lunches will remain the same \$0.35.

The 2019-2020 Application for Educational Benefits packet is now available with links on our website and in our weekly newsletters. If interested, please complete and submit these applications on or before August 28, 2019. A new application needs to be submitted each year.

The September lunch menu will be shared and published the last week of August.
