

## CONFUSED ABOUT YOUR VOTING PRECINCT? WONDER WHICH CANDIDATES ARE IN YOUR DISTRICT?

We were confused too. So CanDo asked some questions and found some answers, thanks to Carrie Colalella of the [Napa County Elections Division](#).

Here's what we learned:

1. The easiest way for a voter to find out their precinct is to call the Elections office: 707.253.4321.

2. If a voter is trying to figure out what they will be voting on for the next election, click [here](#).

After you enter your last name and birth date, it will show your precinct number and your voting status.

3. From there, if you click "View Local Voter Information Guide," it will take you to the sample ballot for your precinct.

4. For the nerds among us, here's an interesting tidbit. Each voter has only ONE precinct number; each digit in that number tells you which district you are in for each of the 5 entities.

For example, precinct 221231 breaks down like this:

2 = Supervisor District

2 = City of Napa

1 = NVUSD

2 = College Board/Board of Education

3 = NVUSD Areas

1 = Precinct ID, 0-9 - Only for those who share the 5 previous numbers and are voting the same ballot; there were too many people in the precinct so they had to be further subdivided.

6. If you're really adventurous, try finding a map of your precinct [here](#). Click "View a list of all maps." Then, click on any map and WAIT for it to load (it can take a while). Once you're there, the map will allow you to input your address (top right corner).

7. Check your voting status, or register to vote, [here](#).
