

SUMMER SCHOOL 2019

Dear Parents:

Today you are receiving information about a summer school program that will be held this year at St. Margaret Mary School for any student who will be entering kindergarten through eighth grade. The program will be held during five weeks of the summer from June 11th- July 18th. Summer school will be held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 8:30-11:30 (PLEASE NOTE THAT DURING THE WEEK OF JULY 1st THERE IS NO SUMMER SCHOOL). If you take vacation during one of the scheduled summer school weeks, you will still have to pay for that week and complete the missing work. It is a five-week program.

The focus of the summer school program will be on meeting the child's individual needs in a small group setting. The areas of concentration will include reading vocabulary and grammar, spelling and writing, and mathematical concepts and operations. Please note that this is a summer school setting, therefore if you enroll your child, he/she will be instructed in all areas.

This year we will also be offering an additional hour each day (from 11:30-12:30) if your child would like to stay to work on his/her summer reading. Mrs. Walsh and the summer school teachers will be working with the children.

Please note that your child does not have to be required to receive summer help in order to enroll in the program. Some parents simply like to have their child review the material taught in the previous year to prepare for the next grade level. Also, your child does not have to be a student at St. Margaret Mary in order to enroll in the program. Since class size will be limited, we need to hear back from you as soon as possible if you are interested in this for your child for the summer.

The instructors for the program will be certified teachers: Mrs. Domzalski, Mrs. Malone, and Mrs. Colley. Mrs. Domzalski currently teaches first grade at St. Margaret Mary. Mrs. Malone has taught kindergarten, fourth, fifth, and seventh grade at St. Margaret Mary. Mrs. Colley currently teaches junior high math at St. Margaret Mary. Mrs. Walsh is the computer teacher at Saint Margaret Mary.

If your child is just enrolling in the summer school program from 8:30-11:30 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, the tuition for the program will be \$90.00 per week. Your child will be receiving 9 hours per week of instruction. If there are siblings who would like to enroll together, the tuition would be \$75.00 extra per child. The tuition will be due each TUESDAY MORNING. Please note that there will be a \$5.00 per day late fee for any tuition not turned in on Tuesday morning. The checks should be made out to "Mrs. Charlotte Colley."

If your child is enrolling in the summer school program and summer reading (from 8:30-12:30 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays), the tuition will be \$120.

Because this program will be in the summer, your child may wear shorts to school. Also, your child needs to bring a snack each day to provide him/her with a small energy break.

We look forward to working with your child. Please do not hesitate to fill out the attached registration form as soon as possible to ensure your child a place in our summer school program. Please note that there are 2 forms. If you are just enrolling in the summer school program, please fill out that form. If you are enrolling in the summer school and summer reading program, please fill out that form. There will be a \$15.00 registration fee due when you send your form back to school. Please make this check payable to "Mrs. Charlotte Colley." We can only accept a limited number of children in each group, so we will note the date we receive your registration form and fee.
