Mah Jongg is a fun rummy-like game played with tiles rather than cards. It originated in China and became popular in the United States at the beginning of the 20th century. Some people believe the game was played in secret by Chinese royalty to keep the knowledge to themselves and others believe it was invented by a Chinese General to entertain his troops during long months of battle. Either way, it is a game enjoyed by millions of people around the world.
