OIEP Program



Monthly Cash Payments to help Oklahoma companies:

- > Lower the cost of a capital project
- > Improve return on investment by speeding up the completion date
- Increase the size/capacity of a planned expansion
- > Enhance the ability to finance a project
- > Improve employee retention and recruitment

 Program jointly administered by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, Oklahoma Development Finance Authority, Oklahoma Tax Commission and the Oklahoma Manufacturing Alliance. More details and online application can be found at https://www.okcommerce.gov/oiep/

OIEP Eligibility



- Minimum \$50,000 capital investment in facility located in Oklahoma
- Minimum payroll of at least \$625,000 per year
- Must be a "for-profit" business entity
- Projects must be innovative, shorten or strengthen the supply chain for the product being manufactured, or it must be a
 project designed to target new markets
- No double dipping in Oklahoma Quality Jobs Act Programs or Investment Tax Credits while in the program
- No funds spent toward the new project prior to receiving an award letter from the Oklahoma Department of Commerce
- Businesses selected for participation must spend at least 10% of the project budget by September 29th
- Only projects where the net benefit rate of the project is sufficient to sustain a \$25,000 award or greater can participate
- Business must meet all eligibility requirements and follow all program rules as set forth in the OIEP Rules www.okcommerce.gov/oiep

OIEP Project Examples



Innovative, Supply Chain, or New Markets:

- > Expand facility for new CNC machine, production line and new inventory
- Purchase new bagging machine increase sales to retail stores and individual customers
- > Purchase new servers and storage for a data center creating new capabilities
- ➤ Purchase new Multi-Axis CNC lathe increasing efficiency and opportunity to bid on high demand machined parts
- > Purchase automated welding machine eliminate sending work out of state
- Purchase CNC controlled grinder with robotic material handling secure a new contract
- > Purchase new lathe decrease cycle times and help recruit new talent

OIEP Participation 2022 (2nd year after Covid Initial Funding Year)



- ☐ For the 2022 application period, Commerce received 163 submissions for project funding.
- □ Of those applications,122 companies were accepted in the 2022 program which will end Spring 2023.
- □ 14 companies either withdrew or did not meet the required 10% spend threshold deadline to continue in the program. They did not receive any state funding.
- ☐ Of the 108 companies still active in the program (receiving monthly payments), they are generating \$51.3 million in project investments statewide. \$8.14 million of this total investment is state funded.

 - □ Notify approved participants Company contracts awarded; Company can begin project investment
- > June 2023 May 2024
 - ☐ Funding Agreement Signed and Collection of OK Employee Withholding Taxes begins
 - □ Commerce ensures 10% company spend <u>ALL tracking sheets & receipts must be e-mailed **no later than**Sept. 29th otherwise the company will not be able to receive payments or continue in this year's program.</u>
 - ☐ Once 10% investment approved, ODFA begins making monthly payments
 - ☐ Company provides tracking spreadsheet quarterly
