Many across Central Florida are coming together to help in the Name of Jesus Christ, in the Name of Love Himself. Although it seems He might have slept through this storm, He is very much awake and working through His kid brothers and sisters, especially you. Let us remember the people of the beloved commonwealth in our prayers and in our checkbooks.

Here are three ways to help right away:

First, you can give generously through All Saints Church of Winter Park to the Anglican Diocese of The Bahamas & The Turks and Caicos Islands where Bishop Laish Boyd and our brothers and sisters in Christ are reestablishing a network of stability one neighborhood after the next. Second, next time David Yergey loads up a plane, you can be sure the entire parish will know about it by way of our parish communications and social media. For now, keep donating supplies to Air Unlimited in Sanford.
