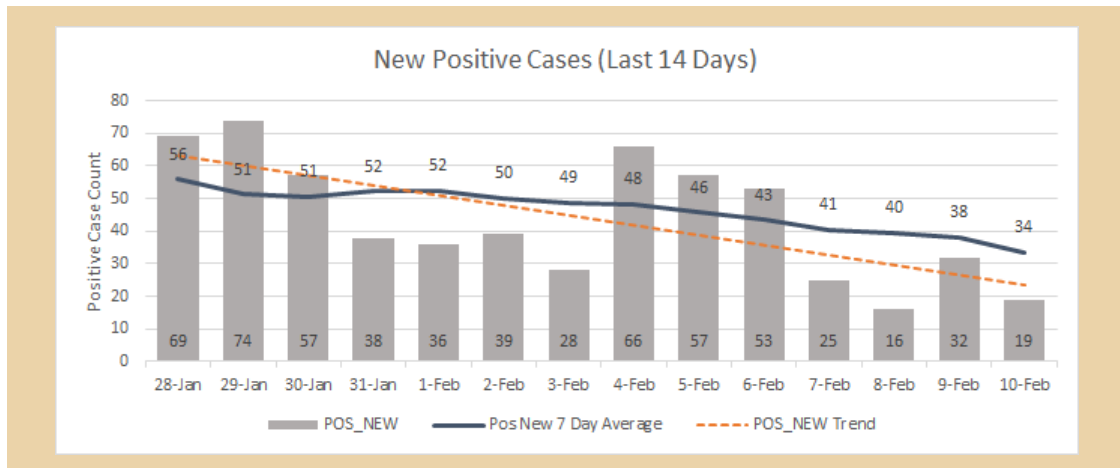

- 4,892 residents have completed their vaccine series

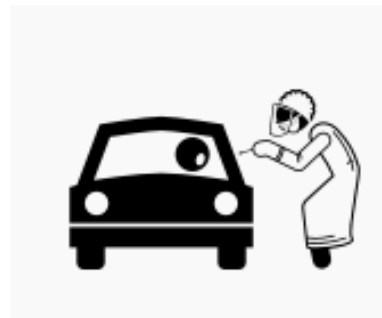
New positive case counts and 7 day average for Outagamie County
