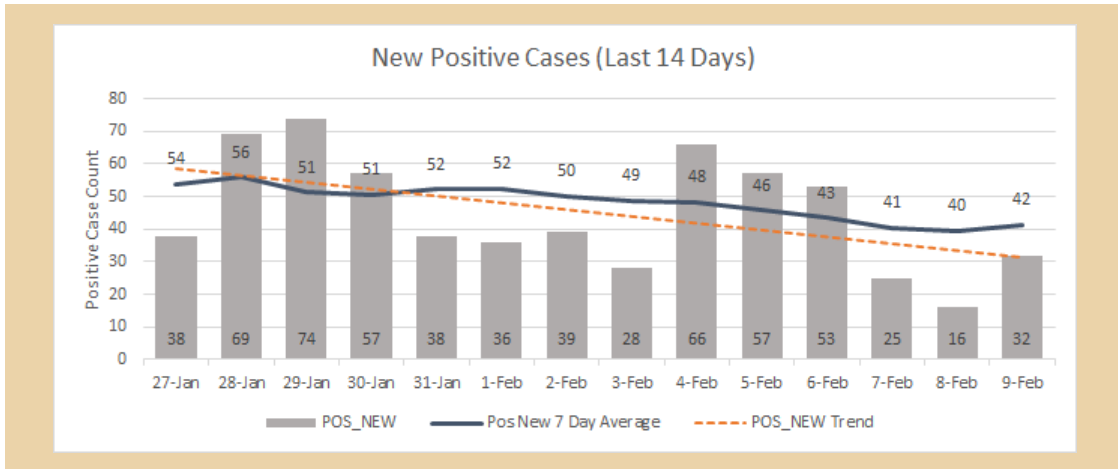

Updates

- On February 6, Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) and laboratory partners identified a second case of variant strain B.1.1.7 of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes [COVID-19, in Wisconsin](#). [View press release here](#).
 - **What is a COVID-19 variant?**
 - A variant is a new strain of the SARS-CoV-2 virus with a specific number of gene mutations that make it unique from the original strain identified.
 - **How are new variants identified?**
 - This is done using a process called whole genome sequencing. Whole genome sequencing takes a sample of the virus and reads the genetic code, the RNA. By doing this, unique strains of the virus are able to be identified.
 - **Does the state screen for COVID-19 variants?**
 - Wisconsin DHS, the Wisconsin State Laboratory of Hygiene, and other laboratory partners regularly work together to ensure whole genome sequencing is performed on a small proportion

of positive tests. Mutations among viruses are very common - it's expected to occur in all viruses, including COVID-19.
