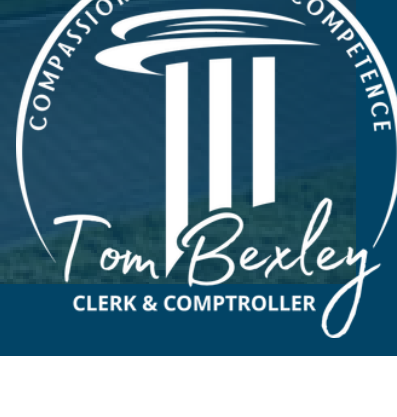

Frequently Asked Questions



How do I search for court records?

Most records are available through the Clerk's online portal.

For sealed, confidential, or older documents, submit a records request directly to the office.



How do I pay a traffic ticket?

Payments can be made online, by mail, over the phone, or in person.

If you want to elect traffic school, check deadlines and eligibility on the Clerk's website.



How do I get a marriage license?

Both applicants must appear in person with valid ID.

Florida residents may have a three-day waiting period unless they complete a premarital course.
