Friday, February 1

John 14:15: (Jesus said) If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

~ Lord Jesus, You sum up your commandments: to love one another as you love us. Today, help me love those who are difficult to love and to love myself without judgment.

Saturday, February 2

Isaiah 26:4: Trust in the LORD forever, for in the Lord God you have an everlasting rock.

~ Loving Lord, it is hard for me to trust sometimes – I am not sure why it is hard for me to let go and give control to you. Your promises are true. Help me to trust today.

Sunday, February 3

John 14: 17b: You know him, because he lives with you and will be with you.

~ Lord, sometimes I don't understand what you are saying. Clear my head so that I might understand with my mind and respond with my heart and know with my soul and act in your strength.

Monday, February 4

John 14:18: (Jesus said) I won't leave you as orphans. I will come to you.

~ Lord Jesus, your words are a comfort – to know that you are with us always through the Holy Spirit, that we are not alone. Help me remember that you are always with me. Let me see your face today in the people I meet.

Tuesday, February 5

Philippians 4:13: I can do all things through him who strengthens me.

Monday, February 11

Tuesday, February 12

Wednesday, February 13

Thursday, February 14
