Wednesday, January 1

John 14:15 | (Jesus said) If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

~ ~ Lord Jesus, You sum up your commandments: to love one another as you love us. Today, help me love those who are difficult to love and to love myself without judgment.

Thursday, January 2

Isaiah 26:4 | Trust in the LORD forever, for in the Lord God you have an everlasting rock.

~ Loving Lord, it is hard for me to trust sometimes, I am not sure why it is hard for me to let go and give control to you. Your promises are true. Help me to trust today.

Friday, January 3

John 14:17b | You know him, because he lives with you and will be with you.

~ Lord, sometimes I don't understand what you are saying. Clear my head so that I might understand with my mind and respond with my heart and know with my soul and act in your strength.

Saturday, January 4

John 14:18 | (Jesus said) I won't leave you as orphans. I will come to you.

~ Lord Jesus, your words are a comfort – to know that you will come again, that we will not be alone. Help me remember that you are always with me. Let me see your face today in the people I meet.

Sunday, January 5

Philippians 4:13 | I can do all things through him who strengthens me.

~ Gracious God, you promise I can do even the hard, the impossible things when I depend on you for my strength. Thank you. Help me today: _____.

Monday, January 6

Psalm 23:4 | Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil; for you are with me.

~ Holy God, I trust in you to walk with me everyday. Today I hold fast to your hand.

Tuesday, January 7

1 Peter 5:7 | Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you.

~ Lord, give me your calmness even in my anxious hours.

Wednesday, January 8

Psalm 55:22 | Cast your burden on the LORD, and he will sustain you: he will never permit the righteous to be moved.

~ Lord Jesus, I do not have to carry my burdens alone. You give me friends and companions to share my heavy load. Always you are with me –carrying me in your arms.

Thursday, January 9

Matthew 7:12 | “In everything do to others, as you would have them do to you, for this is the law and the prophets.”

Friday, January 10

Matthew 7:24 | “Everyone then who hears these words of mine and acts on them will be like a wise man who built his house on rock.”

Saturday, January 11

Matthew 9:9 | ...and he said to him, “Follow me.”

Sunday, January 12

Galatians 5:22-23 | ...the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and selfcontrol. There is no law against such things.

~ Gracious Spirit, fill me with your power so that your fruit may be evidenced in my life today as I follow you.

Monday, January 13

I John 4:8-9 | Who ever does not love does not know God, for God is love. God's love was revealed among us in this way: God sent his only Son into the world so that we might live through him.

~ Loving God, help us show your love to everyone and to live a life as shown by Jesus the Christ.

Tuesday, January 14

I Peter 3:9: Do not repay evil for evil or abuse for abuse; but on the contrary, repay with a blessing. It is for this you were called – that you might inherit a blessing.

~ God of All, you call us to be a blessing. Show me how to be a blessing to others today.

Wednesday, January 15

James 4:17: Anyone, then, who knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, commits sin.

~ Loving God, we know what is right, but sometimes to do the right thing is hard. Help us and show us the way to live in harmony with you, even if it is hard.

Thursday, January 16

Psalm 51: 10: Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me.

Friday, January 17

Isaiah 41:10: . . . do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God.

Saturday, January 18

Romans 8:27 | ... knows how the Spirit thinks, because it pleads for the saints, consistent with God's will.

Friday, January 24

Romans 8:28 | We know that God works all things together for good for the ones who love God, for those who are called according to his purpose.

Saturday, January 25

Matthew 6:14-15 | For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you ...

~ Merciful God, thank you for your forgiveness and grace. Give me the power to really forgive others as you have forgiven me. Today I forgive _____.

Sunday, January 26

I Corinthians 12:4-6 | There are different spiritual gifts but the same Spirit, and there are different ministries and the same Lord, and there are different activities but the same God who produces all of them in everyone.

~ Almighty God, there are times that I do not believe in my own giftedness. I think that I am worthless. But, you do give everyone gifts, even those who think they are not worthy. Today, I recognize that you have given me spiritual gifts.

Thursday, January 30

Friday, January 31

Allow God to speak to you in the silence. Offer a prayer out of your reflection.
