The mission of Montgomery County Veterans Service is to provide the most beneficial service to the veterans and their dependents of this county in a compassionate manner with the desire to obtain the most advantageous benefits available to them, through continual education of VA regulations and application procedures affecting the veteran population.

#### Services Offered:

- Inform veterans, dependents and/or survivors about benefits available through the Dept. of Veterans Affairs.
- Complete necessary DVA forms to establish eligibility to VA for benefits.
- Assist claimant in obtaining supporting documentation. (Discharge/DD-214m, marriage cert., death cert., divorce decrees, etc).
- Assist in referrals to other government agencies for additional benefits, Social Security, Texas Department of Human Services, Texas Work Force Commission, etc.
- Home visits are made to those claimants who because of disabilities are not able to come in to the office.
