The warehouse and forklift training program will prepare you for employment in a warehouse and distribution center. You will be offered training in forklift operation, inventory and warehouse procedures, computerized inventory systems, OSHA regulations, use of warehouse equipment such as pallet jacks and strapping machines, logistics and materials handling, and teamwork and workplace communication. Careers you will be trained for include those listed below.
