## The Buzz on Budgets

- The County of Sacramento is in Phase 2 of allocating the \$150.7M plan to address COVID-19 reliefs, Addressing housing and homelessness is at the top of the priority list.
- The City of Sacramento intends to also address housing and homelessness with \$41M of its budget. A large portion is also slated for Small Business and Commercial Corridor Revitalization plans.

## Reinvestment Plans

- The City of Sacramento's Transportation Priorities Plan has approved over 700 transportation projects throughout the city. In February 2023, the draft plan is slated to be open for community input.

### San Juan Unified School District

- Superintendent Kent Kern announced his retirement earlier this summer. SJUSD has been on a fast track process to internally securing his successor by January 1st.
- The District has moved forward with expanding to a 7-member governing Board and elections for seats of trustee areas 3, 5, 6 & 7 will occur this Fall.

### General Election

- Local elections this fall will determine who represents City Council for Districts 1, 3, 5 & 7 and Board of Supervisors Districts 1, 2 & 5.
- Election Day is Tuesday, November 8th!

## Youth Focus

### Attendance & Parent Advocacy

- Chronic absenteeism impacts 22% of the near 37,000 African American children ages 0-17 in Sacramento County. Local school districts will reinstate Student Attendance Review Board meetings (SARBs) in the 2022-2023 school year. Parents and guardians are encouraged to establish open lines of communication with your child's school. All absences must be reported to your school's attendance line to avoid truancy notices. The more minutes a child spends at school, the greater their chances to make up for learning loss and impacts of Distance Learning.
