

Call to Application: Young Medical Education Innovator Award

The Robert Wood Johnson Medical School's Institute for Excellence in Education is pleased to announce a call for application to the **Young Medical Education Innovator Award** to recognize outstanding junior faculty who have developed innovative approaches to advance medical education at our medical school.

The Young Innovator/Investigator Award will be administered through the Office of Education. Nominees must be full-time faculty at the level of instructor or assistant professor in either a basic science or clinical department of Robert Wood Johnson Medical School. Faculty may nominate themselves or be nominated by their peers, division chief or department chair.

A letter describing the candidate's innovation in medical education should be submitted to Carol A. Terregino, MD, senior associate dean for education and academic affairs, at terregca@rwjms.rutgers.edu, by **April 1**. The Selection Committee will be composed of members of the Institute for Excellence in Education.

Nominee Requirement

The nominee will submit a CV and a personal statement (1 page) describing the following:

- Educational career trajectory, goals and aspirations
- Evidence of educational innovation
- Specific description of how the award will be used to further innovation in medical education. **Selection Criteria** Nominees will be chosen based on the following criteria:
- Evidence of/potential impact of innovation to the educational community at the local, regional or national levels.
