## ENTERING KINDERGARTEN



June 9-12 • Wild Animal Homes • 28337

Do you have any wild neighbors? Opossum, raccoons, and coyotes do not just make their homes in the forest and prairie; sometimes they move in next door to us. Come and learn about these urban dwellers, the ways they obtain resources in the city, and how we can support them in our backyards!

July 14-17 • Legends & Myths • 28342

Have you heard of the healing dragonfly, the courageous hawk, or the greedy bobcat? We will dive into Native American folklore as we explore the different ecosystems and learn about the animals that live within each habitat.



## ENTERING 3RD & 4TH



June 23-26 • Nature Networks • 28339

Come learn about the interactions between plants and animals. Through field experiments and investigations, we will see how many species share resources, exchange energy through cycles, and communicate with each other. You will appreciate how everything reaches a balance when nature is networking.

July 21-24 • Wildlife's Suits of Armor • 28343

Scales, shells, and exoskeletons are protective armor that helps animals survive. Register for this adventure and examine animal coverings, discuss how animals use them, and how scientists transform wildlife's suits of armor into bioinspirations.
