### General Information

The Swimming Pool Operator’s Course provides pool operators with practical knowledge on how to operate and maintain swimming pools safely in accordance with provincial health regulations. Topics covered include disease/injury prevention, basic pool calculations, recirculation system, filtration, water chemistry, pool water disinfection, types of disinfectants, water samples/testing and daily operation.

## **Cancellation Policy**
