The South East Sport, Culture & Recreation District held its **virtual annual general meeting** on May 28, 2020. The Agenda included receiving the financial statements and the report of the District's auditor, appointing the auditor for the ensuing year, electing directors to the Board for the 2020-21 year, receiving the 2020 annual report of the District and approving bylaw changes brought forward.

Executive Director, Joni Hagen, reported that it is wonderful to pause and reflect on the work of the Board of Directors and the success of the district organization. Many accomplishments were highlighted including a 40% increase in workshop participants compared to the year prior and a 39% increase in newsletter distribution from 2019 to 2020. It was noted that South East District is a one-stop shop for sport, culture and recreation information and resources in the south east region.
