LAYOFFS-TAKEN OUT OF POOL

I reduced my driver list from 6 to 3 and adjusted my random list down to 3. If the 3 laid off drivers return what do I do?

If they have not driven for 30 day before June 5th or 90 days after June 5th as per the 382 waiver, they must be pre employment tested and returned to the pool. You have to query the D & A Clearinghouse if rehiring.

Drug and Alcohol Questions?-



Layoffs-remained in random pool

If they remained in the random pool and were selected during their layoff, they should be random tested when they return to work prior to driving.

If they were NOT selected during the layoff time, then they can return to driving without a drug test.

Drug and Alcohol Question



RANDOM SELECTION

I have not completed my 2nd quarter selection and don't plan to complete my 3rd quarter selection due to drivers not working. Can I complete the remainder of 2020 selection and testing in the 4th quarter?

ANSWER

YES! As long as you meet the proper selection rate for both drug and alcohol testing and complete the correct number of tests. You should document in writing how you managed the 2nd and 3rd quarter selection and postponement of tests.
