**Powerful, award-winning documentary *Gen Silent* reveals the concerns, challenges, and triumphs of several LGBTQ elders in the Greater Boston Area; filmed a decade ago, it remains keenly relevant today as our “rainbow elders” continue to seek care that is informed, competent, and supportive of their sexual and gender identities.**

Julie Nowak (she/they) is the LGBTQ+ Initiative Coordinator for BayPath Elder Services, leading their outreach to this community as well as offering free cultural competency trainings, *Gray Pride: Welcoming & Working with LGBT Older Adults*. Julie is also a longtime facilitator with PFLAG (Parents, Families, and Friends of Lesbians and Gays) and a board member of volunteer organization Gay For Good (G4G) Boston.

After the film, Julie will lead a guided discussion of LGBTQ+ aging concerns and coping strategies, with consideration of our own active roles as Allies to others in our increasingly diverse and aging nation.
